General Characteristics of the District

Location & Geographical Area:

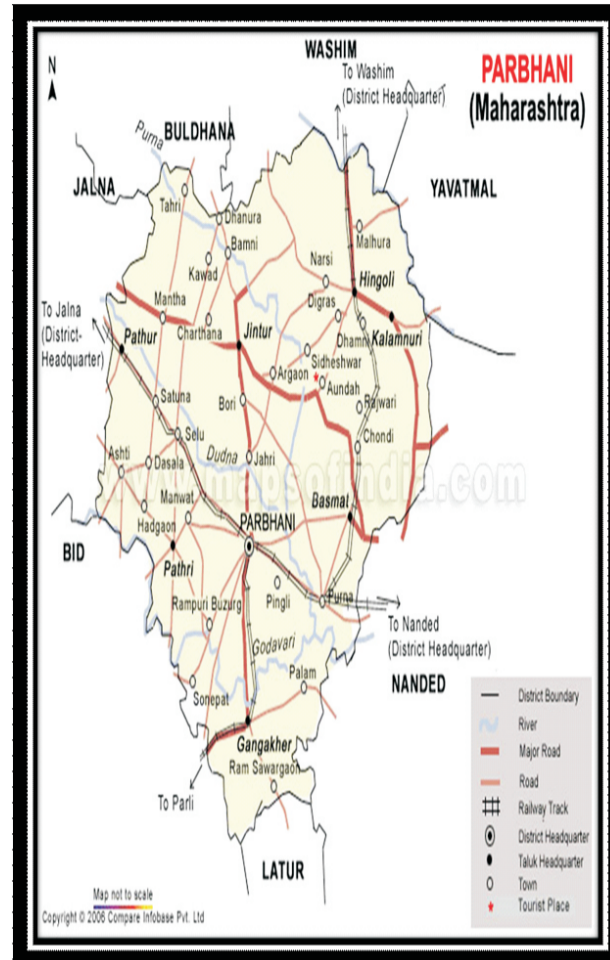
Parbhani, prior otherwise called " Prabhavatinagar ", is one of the Eight locale in the Marathwada area of Maharashtra State .

This whole Marathwada locale, including the region, was a piece of the past Nizam State; later a piece of Hyderabad State; after revamping of states in 1956 it turned into a piece of the then Bombay state; and from 1960 onwards it is a piece of the present Maharashtra state.

Parbhani locale lies in the vicinity of 18.45 and 20.10 North Latitudes and 76.13 and 77.39 East Longitude. Locale Geographical Area 6355 (Sq.km)

The locale is limited on the north by Hingoli area. On the east by Nanded area, on the South by Latur and on the West by Beed and Jalna regions.

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The state capital of Mumbai is to the west; Parbhani is well connected by railway road to other major towns in Maharashtra and also in the neighboring state of Andhra Pradesh.

Industrial In fracture:

Locale Industries Center is in charge of advancing modern improvement and business era through Industries. Other than DIC, Other offices like Br.MSME-DI, Aurangabad ,NSIC Aurangabad ,MIDC, MSSIDC, KVIB, MCED, and MITCON are working as an inseparable unit for the improvement of this District. The State, every once in a while actualizing mechanical strategies with target of making a level - playing field for nothing and reasonable rivalry and strong modern development over the district. Unique accentuation has been laid on the improvement of sufficient and quality foundation in regions.

Improvement of modern hallways, Textile parks, Food Parks and Cluster advancement in not so distant future will make magnificent foundation and speculation openings in the area which in future may help prospering economy.

Topography:

Parbhani district is situated towards the southwest in the State. Hingoli lies to the north of the district, Nanded to the east, Latur and Beed to the south, and Beed and Jalna to its west.

Forest:

The area under forest in the district includes jintur tahasils. The total area of the forest in parbhani district is 39091.81 hectares (96523 acres) It is very less (3.01%) than the requirement of the district. The forest is of mixed deciduous type and consists of Teak, Triman salai, palas, khair, Ber and Babul.

Administrative set up:

Administratively the district is divided 2 Sub Divisions namely Parbhani at and 11 has 9 Tehsils.

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There are 9 Panchayat Samities and 8 Nagar Palikas and 1 Nagar nigam. There are 4 Assembly Constituency in this district.

PROFILE OF NANDED DISTRICT



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Geographic profile of Nanded District

The city of Nanded (Dist. Headquarter) is situated on the banks of the Goda vari and is known by the name of Nandigram in the old religious texts. The history of the city is revealed from a copper plate found at Washim which places the origin of the city some time in the fourth century. A brief profile of the district based upon the gazetteer of Nanded district and district credit plans of the bank is presented in the following manner:

Location:

Nanded lies between 18.15 to 19.55 North latitude and 77.7 to 78.18 East longitudes. The contour of the district is very irregular shape. It is situated on the south east fringes of Maharashtra state demarcating the boundaries of Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka state on the east. The other sides are covered by Latur, Parbhani and Yeshwantpur district of Maharashtra state.

Historical Background:

The district has an ancient and historical background and the same dates back to Satavahana, Chalukya and Rashtrakuta dynasty. The bank of the Godavari River where Nandi the vahana of Lord Shiva, is said to have performed penance, came to be called the Nandi-Tat, which later changed into Nanded. It is also said that the Nine Rishis known as Nandi, performed penance on the bank of the Godavari river and hence the name Nandi Tat. It also formed the boundary of the Nine Nanded rulers of the Magadha Empire.

Area and Topography:

The district has a geographical area of 10528 sq. kms which is 3.41 percent of the total geographical area of Maharashtra; urban area is 211.1 sq. kms. (2.81 percent) and rest is rural area of 10316.9 sq. kms. (97.19 percent)

There are total 1580 urban/semi urban/rural centers out of which 1307 Grampanchayats are and 13 are Urban/semi-urban centers; of which Nanded city has corporation and rest of 12 centers are having municipal councils.

Service Enterprises:

Nanded district has many pilgrim centers like Hujuraheb Gurudwara the ancient temples of Lord Dattatraya and Renuka Devi at Mahur taluka and the temple of Lord Khondoba at Malegaon in Loha, people from different parts of the country visit these places. It was sanctioned for overall development of the city. There is also direct train service from Nanded to Amritsar, started mainly for the convenience of the Sikh pilgrims. In such a background, there is scope for developing the tourism oriented industrial activities like Hotel Industry in places like Nanded, Mahur and Malegaon.

CONCLUSION:

It can be seen from the foregoing discussion that the selected district is more prosperous particularly in agro-based industrial units. The District Industries Center is playing a crucial role in promoting small scale industrial units. According to the national policy, each district is provided a DIC to assist the industrial establishments in supply the required facilities as well as providing training and development. However, there are certain problems they are facing, viz., shortage of required quality inputs, marketing problems, labor problems, technical issues, etc. The various promotional institutions are trying to solve the problems of the small scale units.

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
